
ANNOUNCEMENTS

BLESSSING OF HERBS ON THE ASSUMPTION—

According to tradition, after Our Lady's Assumption into heaven, flowers were found growing out of the sarcophagus in which Mary had been laid, and a sweet odor rose out of the tomb, confirming the Apostles' faith in Our Lady's Assumption. In honor of this tradition, the Church instituted the custom of blessing wild herbs and flowers on the feast of the Assumption. The blessing originated in Germany, and is first attested in the 10th century; one version of it or another is found in a great many of the liturgical books which contain blessings of this sort. If you would like to have your herbs blessed, there will be a table near the front of the church, and one of the priests will bless the herbs after each of the Masses.



SPANISH ADULT CATECHISM CLASS—Beginning in September, at the same time as the regular Adult Catechism class after the Sunday High Mass, St. Lawrence will begin offering a Spanish-language catechism class in room 301 of the parish center. This class will use as a text the Catechism of Pope St. Pius X, which is directed to the lay faithful and in question and answer format similar to the Balltimore catechism. This text was used by Monsignor John Hagan in his *Compendium of Catechetical Instruction*.

FROM THE PARISH LIBRARIAN—The library website is http://stlawrencechurchlibrary.goAlexandria.com. I hope you have been exploring the website! We have begun barcoding the books. The next sections are Aquinas, Apostasy, Apparitions and Miracles. Saint Thomas Aquinas needs no introduction. There is a whole series by him in the reference section, but in this lending section there are books by and written about his works. Apostasy can mean either a refusal to follow Catholicism or a total abandonment of it. Also, disobedience can count as apostasy and interatio baptismatis which means repetition of Baptism. This section is small, at the moment. Lastly, Apparitions and Miracles are exactly that. You will find Fatima in this section but also books on reported miracles.

ST. TABITHA CHILDREN'S SEWING CLASS—This free instructional class, new this fall, is geared children age 9 to 14 years old who want to learn hand and machine sewing. Boys and girls are both welcome, with projects being tailored to fit each group. No sewing machine purchase required, but parents are required to provide materials at the instructor's discretion. Notes on Today's Music

Recessional Music: Carillon de Westminster, Opus 54, No. 6,

Louis Vierne (1870–1937)

Kyriale: Mass XI, 740; Credo IV, 780

Offertory Antiphon: *Exaltabo Te*, Giovanni Croce (1557–1609) Communion Motet: *Cantate Domino*, Giuseppe Ottavio Pitoni

The Offertory Antiphon this week is sung chorally set by Giovanni Croce. The text is from Psalm 29:2-3: *I will magnify thee, O Lord, for thou hast set me up: and not made my foes to triumph over me.O Lord my God, I cried unto thee: and thou hast healed me.* Croce's sets each line of text in short sections with pairs or trios of voices that are followed soon by any remaining voices. He also makes use of the harmonic minor scale which creates a more brighter mood as the melodies rise and darker as they descend.

The motet *Cantate Domino* is a setting of Psalm 149:1–2 by Baroque Italian composer **Giuseppe Ottavio Pitoni**. Pitoni's work, like much of late Baroque music, is tightly structured in small phrases with two main sections and follows the general format of "A-B-A.", also called ternary form.

Giuseppe Ottavio Pitoni (1657–1743) was an Italian vocalist, organist and composer. He studied voice from the age of five and became a *maestro di cappella* (choirmaster) at *Santa Maria Maggiore*, Monterotondo, a historic church near Rome by sixteen. Pitoni held director positions at many parishes in Rome and was a prominent church musician during the late Baroque era.


