MASS INTENTIONS FOR 2025 CLOSED—We are grateful for the many Mass intention requests we receive. However, we are not accepting any new Mass intentions until further notice. Our dates are filled for the remainder of the year, and we are not yet accepting intentions for 2026. Any new requests received after today will be returned. If there is no return address, the money will be placed in the candle donation box.

NO ALTAR BOY MEETING—Due to the parking situation there will be no altar boy meeting this month.

NO GIRLS' SODALITY MEETING—Due to the parking situation there will be no girls' sodality meeting this month.

SATURDAY PARKING—Free Saturday parking has ended, but we are doing everything we can to try to get it back or find some other relief. Until now, as described on our website, parishioners have had the option to use the mobile code LUVHBG to get free parking on Saturdays instead of paying the very high fee of \$4 per hour between 8am and 5pm.

The parking fees for Harrisburg are subject to oversight from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development because of an agreement struck between the city of Harrisburg and the state years ago to avert the city's bankruptcy.

Many of you have contacted your state senators and representatives, for which we are grateful, but even the elected officials are not aware that the parking rules fall under state authority. We ask you to continue your efforts, while also writing to the govenor, making the following points:

- Parking rates and rules are under the Department of Community and Economic Development due to the city-state agreement.
- Until April 26, 2025, parishioners could use the LUVH-BG parking code for free on Saturdays. This has been taken away, and we had only two weeks notice about it.
- This is a mistaken policy, which will eliminate many Saturday activities at our parish by making too expensive to park here on Saturdays between 8a.m. and 5p.m.
- Please ask your state officials to reinstate free Saturday parking until an impact can be completed.

Notes on Today's Music

Processional Hymn: On This Day, the First of Days, 945 Recessional hymn: The King of Love, My Shepherd Is, 874 Kyriale: I, 696; Credo III, 776

Offertory Motet: O quam metuendus est, Tomás Luis de Victoria Communion Antiphon: Ego Sum Pastor, Heinrich Isaac (c.1450-1517)

The motet O quam metuendus est by Tomás Luis de Victoria is a setting of the Magnificat antiphon for the dedication of a church. This past week marked the 107th anniversary of St. Lawrence's dedication. The text is taken from the description of Jacob's Ladder in Genesis: "How awe-inspiring is this place! Surely this can be nothing else but the house of God and the gate of heaven."

Tomás Luis de Victoria (c.1548–1611), along with Palestrina and de Lassus, is one of the greatest composers of the 16th C., famous for its ethereal polyphony. Ordained a priest at age 27, he lived in Rome for years, and assisted St. Philip Neri as chaplain of San Girolamo della Carità.


