DIOCESAN NOTE ON SCHISMATIC MASS—A few days ago we received a note from the Diocese of Harrisburg warning Catholics about the importance of remaining united with the Pope and the local Bishop, and avoiding worshipping with priests who reject their authority. Here is the note: “Recently, a group has been gathering at a Harrisburg area hotel on Sunday for a Latin Mass. The person presenting himself as a priest is a member of the Roman Catholic Institute, a schismatic group that rejects the authority of the Holy Father, the local Bishop and the validity of the Second Vatican Council. This group is not in communion with the Roman Catholic Church, and Catholics should not participate in these services.”

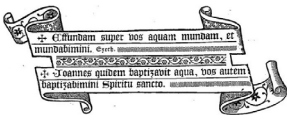

Notes on Today's Music Processional hymn: <i>Holy, Holy, Holy</i>, 929 Recessional hymn: <i>O God, Almighty Father</i>, 977 Kyriale: III, 705; Credo II, 772 Responsory: <i>Tibi laus</i>, Orlandus Lassus Communion antiphon: <i>Benedicimus Deum</i>, John Mason Following the offertory chant the Responsory <i>Tibi Laus</i> by Orlandus Lassus will be sung. Those who have assisted at <i>Tenebrae</i> will recall that office is a combination of <i>Matins</i> and <i>Lauds</i> which are the first two hours of the Divine Office. During <i>Matins</i>, each of the nine readings are followed by a responsory. <i>Tibi Laus</i> is the refrain portion of the fifth Responsory from <i>Matins</i> today. The responsory is usually in two parts: a respond (or refrain) which is often split in two, and a verse. In the second half of Lassus's setting, the words <i>O beata Trinitas</i> are sung three times with three of the four voices in rhythmic unison which emphasizes the "three in one." Orlandus Lassus (c.1532–1594) is known for the mature polyphonic style in the Franco-Flemish school. He wrote over 2,000 works in Latin, French, Italian, and German both sacred and secular. Lassus along with Giovanni Pierluigi da Palestrina and Tomás Luis de Victoria are the most influential composers of the late Renaissance.
