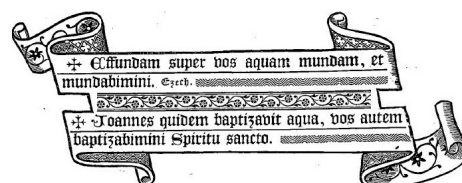

Notes on Today's Music

Processional hymn: *My God, Accept My Heart This Day*, 942
 Recessional hymn: *Lord, Enthroned in Heav'nly Splendor*, 939
 Kyriale: XI, 740; Credo: II, 772

Antiphon after Offertory: *Ave Verum Corpus*, Chant
 Hymn during Communion: *Festivis resonent*, Chant

The prayer *Ave Verum Corpus* is a short Eucharistic hymn dating from the 14th century and attributed to Pope Innocent VI (d. 1362). During the Middle Ages the prayer was sung at the elevation during the consecration at Mass.

The month of July is dedicated to the Most Precious Blood of Our Lord with its titular feast on the first of the month. The hymn sung at Vespers for this feast is *Festivis resonent*. The second verse translates as: *While we, with tears and sighs profound, That memorable Blood record, Which, stretch'd on his hard Cross, from many a wound The dying Jesus pour'd.*

PARKING GARAGE REFUNDS—If you had a problem with the South Street Garage accepting your parking voucher last weekend, you can make a claim to get reimbursed at www.myparkingrefund.com/refund_form.php. This refund comes directly from the garage; the church is not charged. Even if you do not have your receipt if you provide the last four digits of your credit card and the date on which you parked a refund should be provided. The garage says you should hear back from them within seven business days of completing the form. Park Harrisburg has acknowledged they experienced “hiccups” with the system accepting vouchers last Saturday. They understand that the left gate is more reliable than the right to take the vouchers but are working to get them both to accept the vouchers. If you have any problems, please request the refund at the above link, and please also notify the office so we can stay on top of the issue.

FREE SAT. & SUN. GARAGE PARKING—Our South Street Garage parking vouchers are valid both on Saturdays and Sundays. We now are offering self-service for obtaining vouchers. A sign-out sheet and vouchers are available at the back of the church and also on the table outside the parish office door. The South Street garage is available on Saturdays 7:30am - 8pm and on Sundays 7am-2pm.
